Follow the current events of any branch of science.

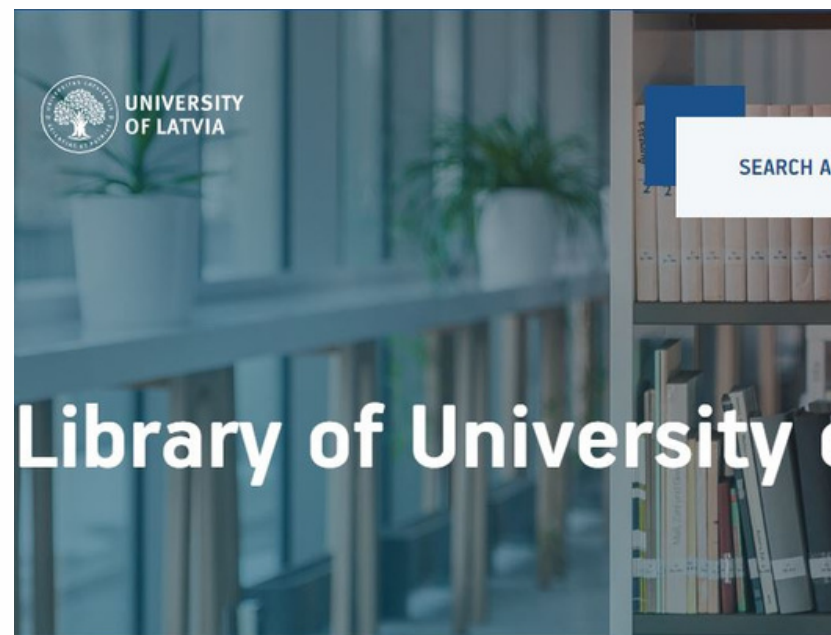
## **Free access provided**

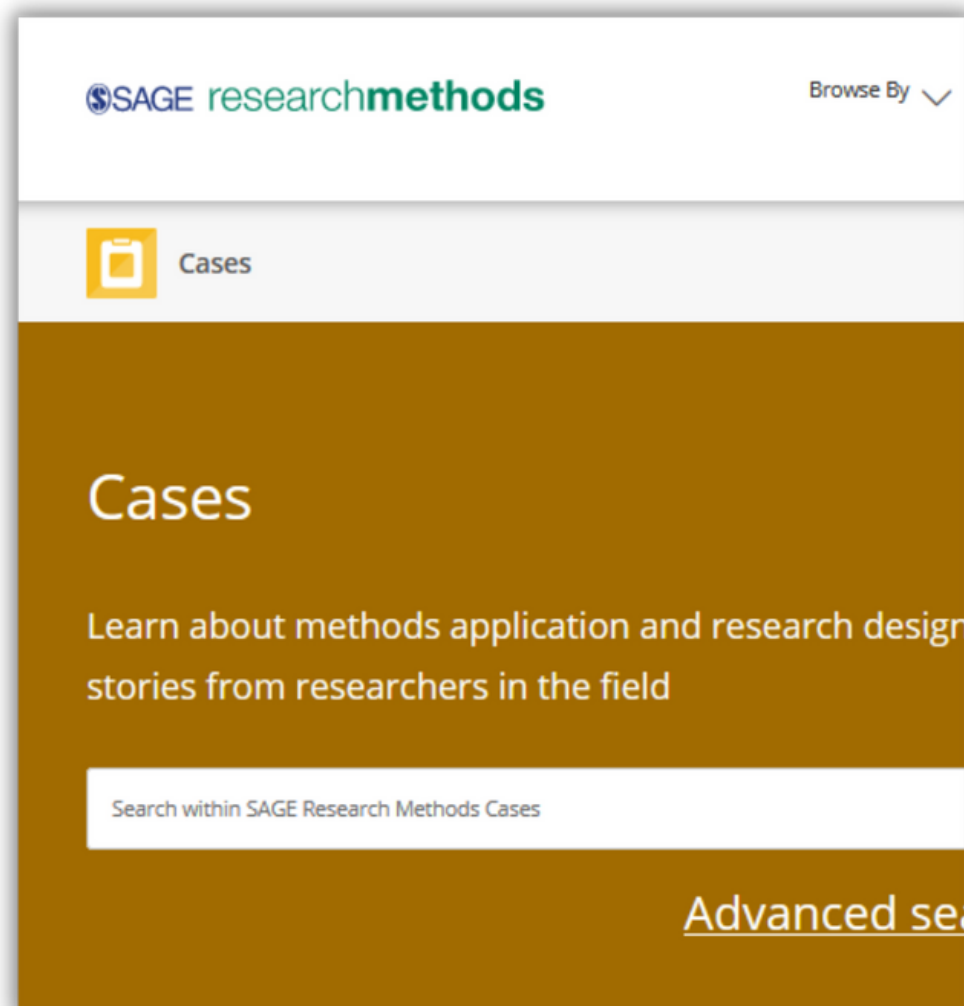
# SAGE Research Methods Books and Reference collection

# SAGE Research Methods Cases collection

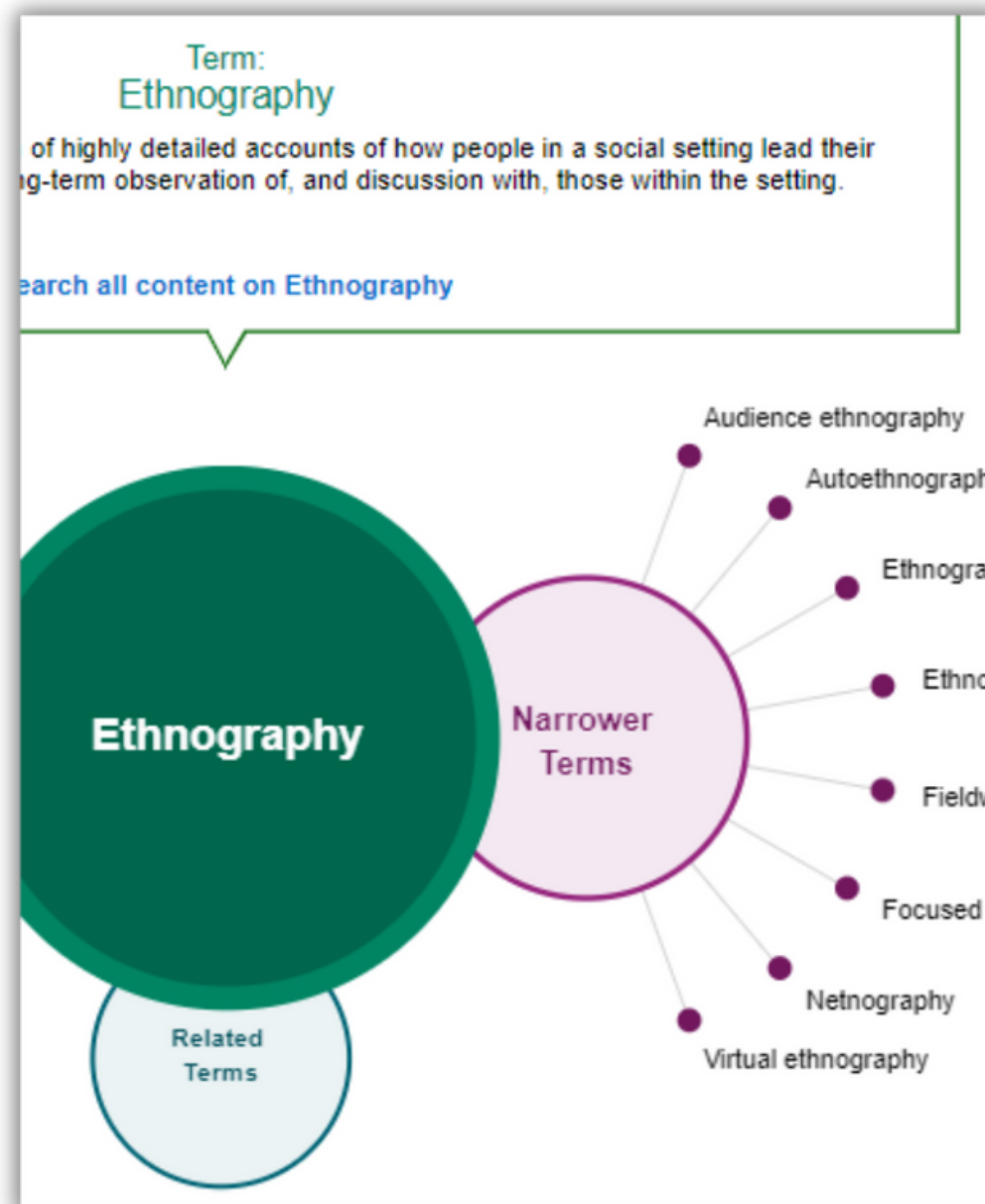


The collection provides case studies of actual research projects from many different disciplines to show how methods are applied.

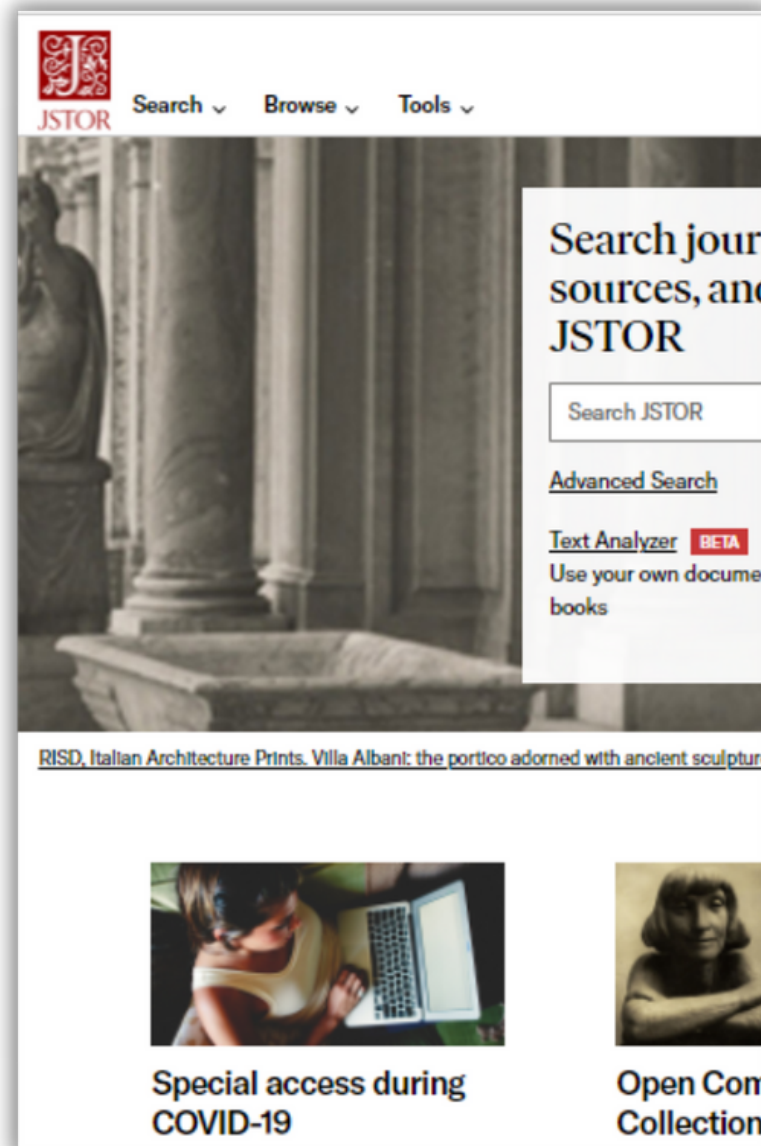

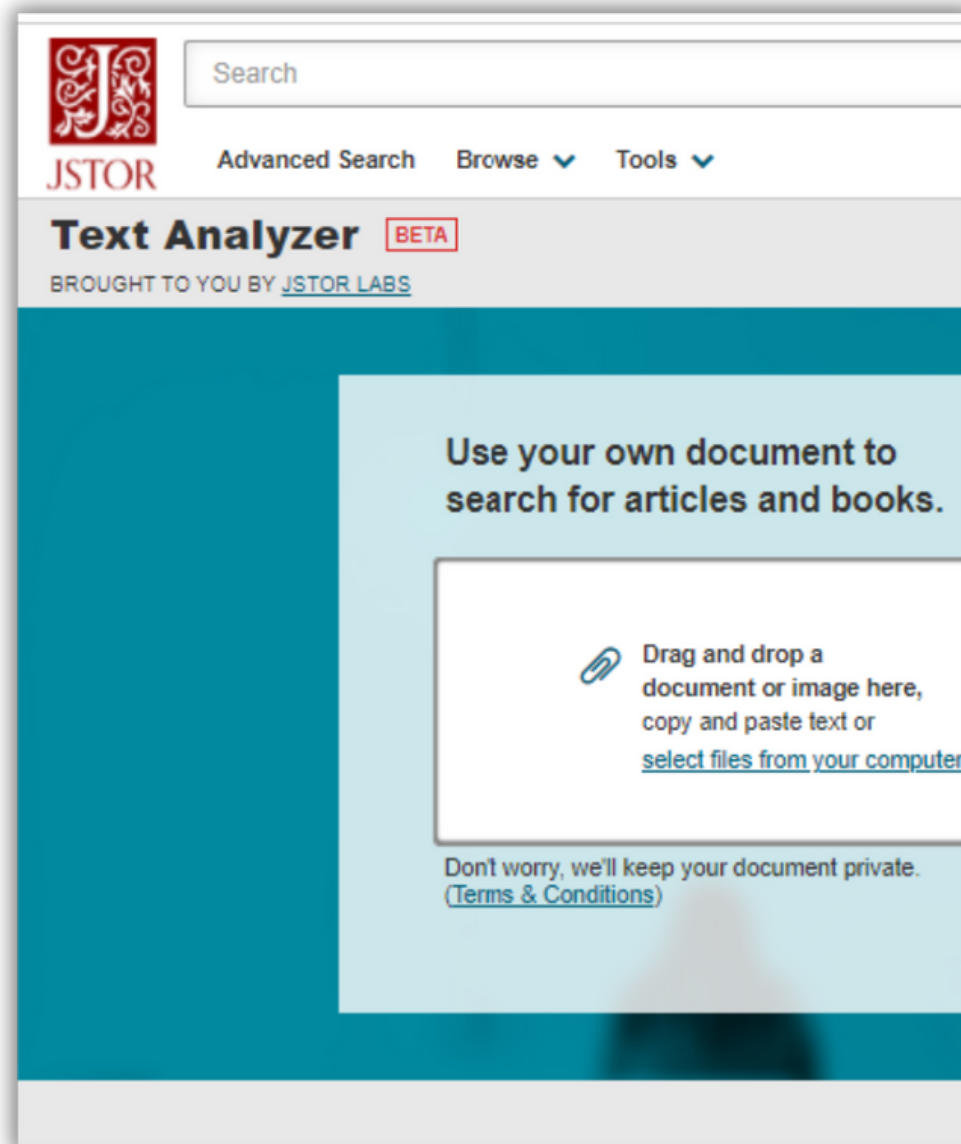

Upload a selected text, text snippet, or document in *Text Analyser* tool. Text Analyzer processes the keywords found in it, then searches for equivalent titles and documents with similar content available in the JSTOR database. The search tool offers a creative approach to the research process.

# Basic search



**Basic search or simple search is available in all databases as first search option on the main page**

## **Use to:**

- perform a quick search for one, several keywords or a phrase;
- search by one search criteria - author, title, subject, etc.

## **Results:**

- broad (in numbers more than in advanced search),
- general,
- often inaccurate.

# Advanced search



Advanced search is available in most databases as a second search option

## Use to:

- perform a more complex search,
- combine several keywords and phrases with the Boolean operators AND, OR, NOT,
- combine several search criteria - author, title, subject, etc.,
- apply filters - resource type, publication date, language, subject, etc.

## Results:

- narrower (fewer in number than in basic search),
- more precisely.



# Boolean operators

## AND, OR, NOT



**Boolean operators or Boolean logic show logical links between search keywords**

They are used in basic and advanced search to combine keywords, phrases, search criteria and broader or narrow search results.

### AND

Is used to:

- indicate that all entered keywords should be selected

Reduce the amount of records returned

### OR

Is used to:

- indicate that at least one of the entered keywords should be selected.

Expand the amount of records returned

### NOT

Is used to:

- indicate that first not second keyword should be selected.

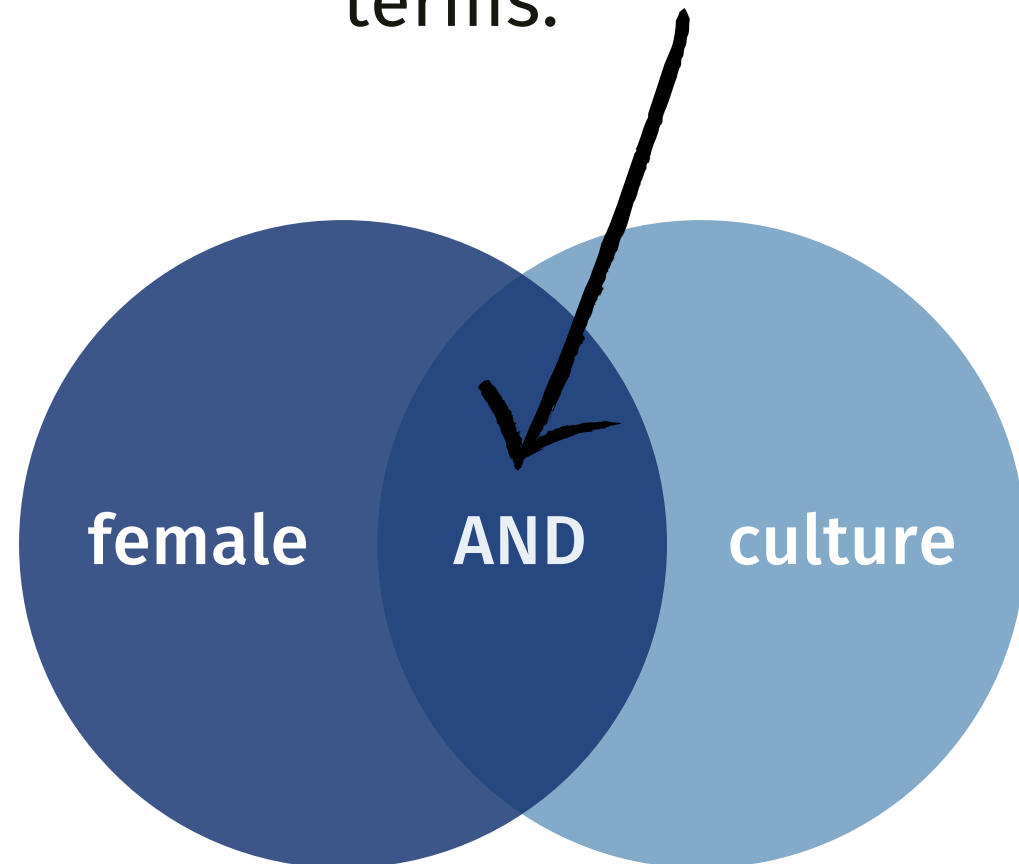
Reduce the amount of records returned

## AND

jaunieši AND kino

Search :for

- documents containing both terms.

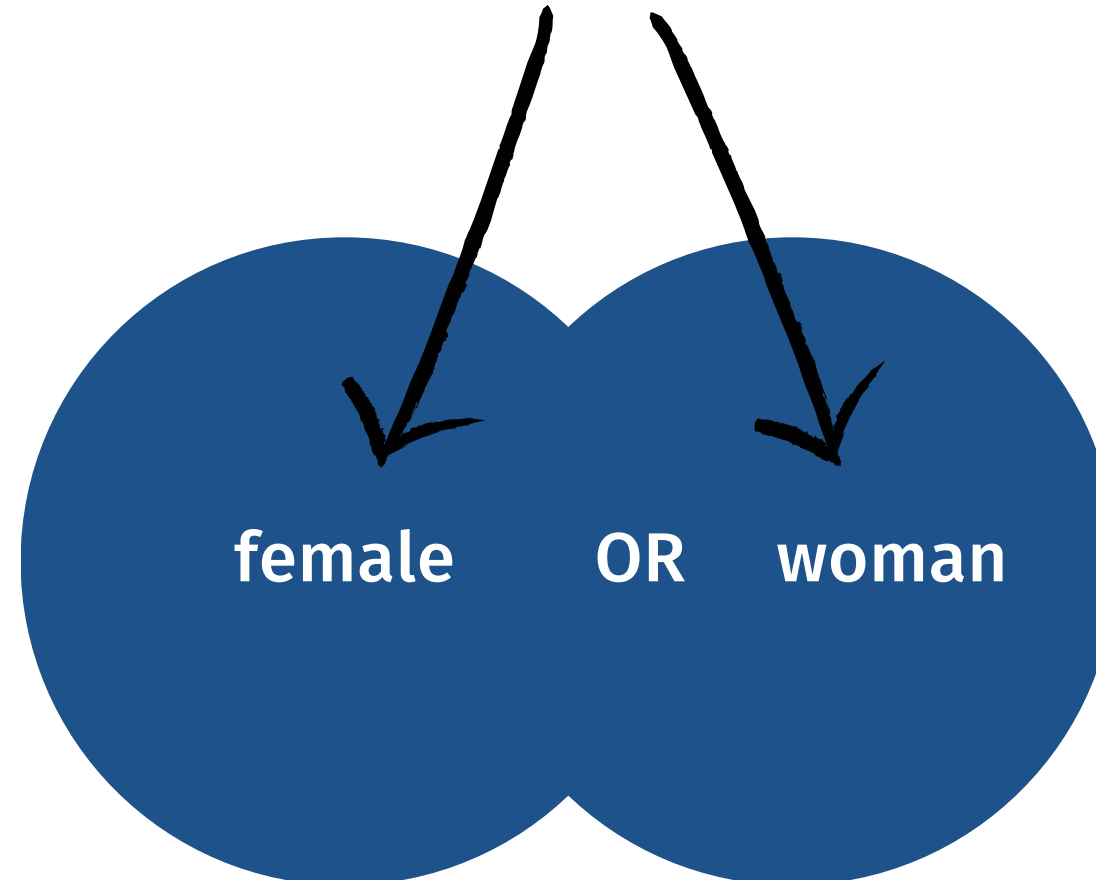


## OR

latvian OR lithuanian

Search for:

- documents containing at least one of two terms.

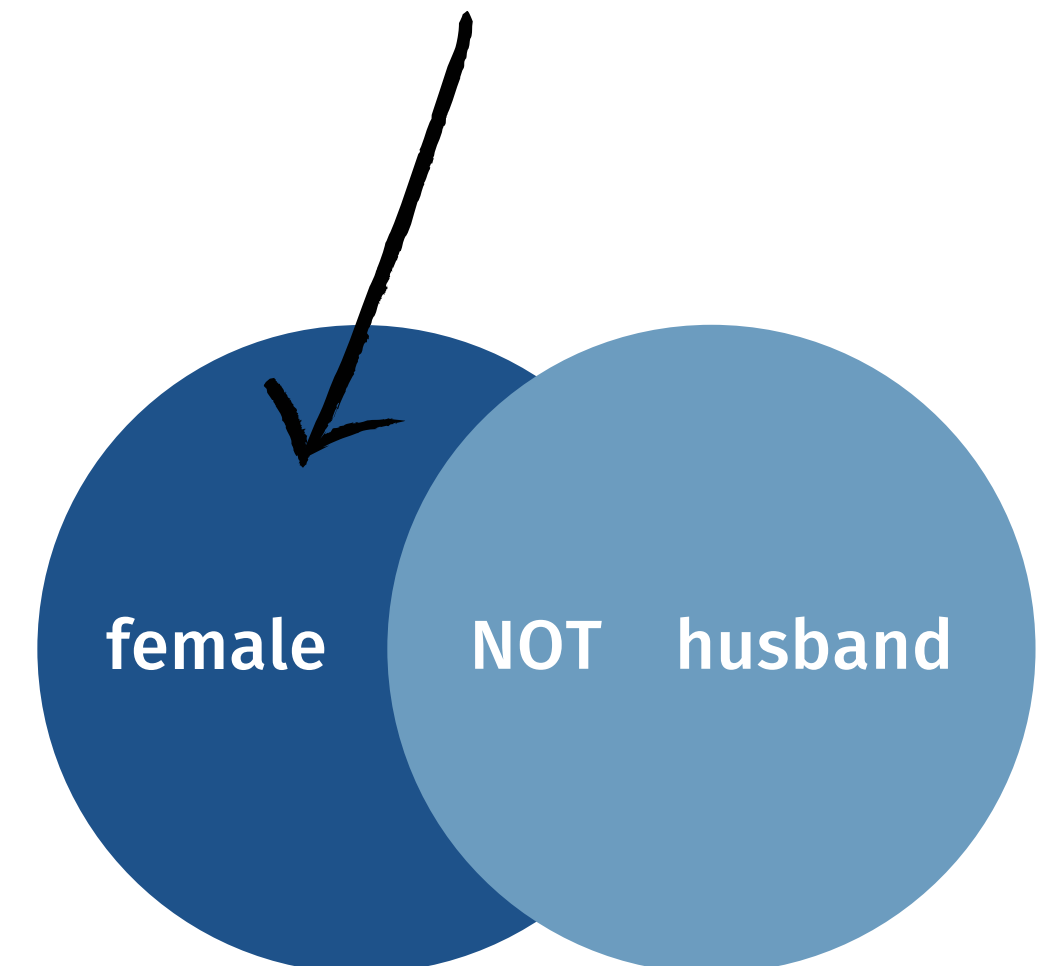


## NOT

kino NOT televīzija

Search for:

- documents that do not contain second term



# Browsing



**Browse is a search type offered by most of databases as a third search option**

Browsing option is used to select object in list by scrolling through them. Lists are created according to certain criteria.

It is used when there is no clear understanding of the subject being searched for. Browsing is intuitive, time consuming.

## **Browse list criteria:**

- subject, disciplin,
- title,
- author,
- publisher,
- etc.

# Filters



Used to refine and narrow search results

Results can be filtered by the following criteria:

- type of resource: book, book chapter, journal, journal article, video, image, etc.,
- publication date,
- language,
- subject,
- access type: all content, content subscriber have full access to,
- etc.
